CHAMBERLAIN HRDLICKA'S GREGG JACOBSON SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE IN ANTI-DEFAMATION LEAGUE'S GLASS LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

ATLANTA, July 10, 2017 – Chamberlain, Hrdlicka, White, Williams & Aughtry announces that associate Gregg M. Jacobson has been selected to participate in the Anti-Defamation League's (ADL) 2017-2018 Glass Leadership Institute (GLI). This competitive year-long program is a nationally recognized leadership development program designed to give a select group of young professionals an up-close and personal view of the programs, policies and expertise of the ADL. The program serves as a comprehensive introduction to ADL and provides a pathway into an impressive network of ADL young professional leaders.
