The Personal Information We Collect

Foster Swift does not collect any personally identifiable information (PII) about you unless you voluntarily provide it to us. For example, we collect your contact information if you choose to e-mail us with that information, subscribe to a newsletter or blog or submit a job application.

Automatically Collected Information

Information about your computer and your visit are automatically collected, such as your IP address or the type of browser you are using, the search terms you use on our website, the specific web pages you visit on our Website, and the duration of your visits. It is important to note, this information reveals nothing personal about you and is reported only in aggregate.

Our Use and Sharing of Your PII

We use the PII you provide us to deliver the information and services you request or which we feel may interest you. Foster Swift will not give, rent, or sell your PII. We will not share your PII outside Foster Swift with the exception that we may share your PII with third parties that perform data services, such as maintenance and back up. Any such third parties will be under an obligation to maintain the confidentiality of your PII.

We use the information collected automatically in a variety of ways, such as to analyze site traffic (such as aggregated information on the pages visited by our users), which allows us to improve the design and content of our website.

Foster Swift cannot guarantee the protection of the information you send to us by means of unencrypted email, or that may be accessible by others while in transit.

Links to Third-Party Sites

Our Website may link to or contain links to other third party websites that we do not control or maintain. We are not responsible for the privacy practices employed by any third party website.

Tracking User Behavior



Foster Swift uses "cookies" and "web beacons" (also called "clear gifs" or "pixel tags") to obtain certain types of information when your web browser accesses our website. It is important to note that the cookies and web beacons that we use are not tied to personal information. We use cookies and web beacons to collect anonymous, aggregated information to assist us in understanding how users use our Website. We do not use any of this information to identify visitors and we do not share it with third parties.

Disabling Cookies

You are not required to accept cookies. However, some parts of our website will not function properly or be available to you if you refuse to accept a cookie or choose to disable the acceptance of cookies.

Our Commitment to Security
