



Storey Receives 2021 Theodore W. Swift Civility Award

LANSING, Mich. —Foster Swift attorney Scott A. Storey is the 2021 recipient of the Ingham County Bar Association's (ICBA) Theodore W. Swift Civility Award.

Named after and first given posthumously to the firm's name partner in 2000, this award is presented to a member of the ICBA who has "distinguished himself or herself by manifesting civility in his or her relations with the Bench, Bar, clients, and the public, while adhering to and advancing the highest principles and traditions of the legal profession."
